9 AN ACT TO REDUCE THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF MONEY IN THE
10 SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT AND RECYCLING FUND THAT THE
11 ARKANSAS DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY MAY USE
12 FOR ADMINISTRATIVE PURPOSES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

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16 TO REDUCE THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF MONEY IN
17 THE SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT AND RECYCLING
18 FUND THAT THE ARKANSAS DEPARTMENT OF
19 ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY MAY USE FOR
20 ADMINISTRATIVE PURPOSES.

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23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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25 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 8-6-605(a)(4), concerning the Solid Waste
26 Management and Recycling Fund, is amended to read as follows:

27 (4) No more than ~~twenty-five percent (25%)~~ five percent (5%) of
28 the moneys received annually into the fund shall be used by the department
29 for the administration of a solid waste management and recycling program and
30 for solid waste management compliance and enforcement activities at landfills
31 and open dumps.

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33 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 8-6-609(b)(1)(B), concerning the grant
34 program under the Solid Waste Management and Recycling Fund Act, is amended
35 to read as follows:

36 (B) Funds collected under ~~the provisions of~~ § 8-6-607 and



1 deposited ~~in~~ into the State Treasury to the credit of the Solid Waste
2 Management and Recycling Fund, less up to ~~twenty-five percent (25%)~~ five
3 percent (5%) for administrative support for the department, shall be annually
4 allocated to each of the approved regional solid waste management districts
5 for costs eligible for grant assistance utilizing a combination of two (2)
6 methods, ~~hereafter~~ referred to in this section as "method A" and "method B".
