Transportation/Hazardous Materials: AOMA/PMAA Reminder Regarding HAZMAT Registration



The Petroleum Marketers Association of America ("PMAA") and its state chapter The Arkansas Oil Marketers Association ("AOMA") published in their June 15th newsletters a reminder regarding the United States Department of Transportation Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration ("PHMSA") Annual Hazardous Materials Registration.

Both PMAA and AOMA state that PHMSA:

... requires hazardous material transporters to register and pay a fee for annual registration in return for a Certificate of Operation. PHMSA began mailing the 2017-2018 registration information to HAZMAT transporters in April. Only those with expiring DOT PHMSA HAZMAT registration certificates must reregister before July 1, 2018, or risk losing authority to operate and pay a substantial penalty.

The organizations also provide a reminder that the validity of Hazmat registration certificates is checked at roadside inspections.
