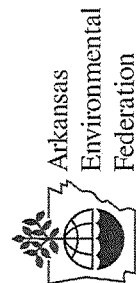
## About the AEF

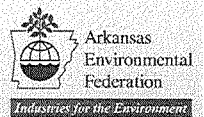

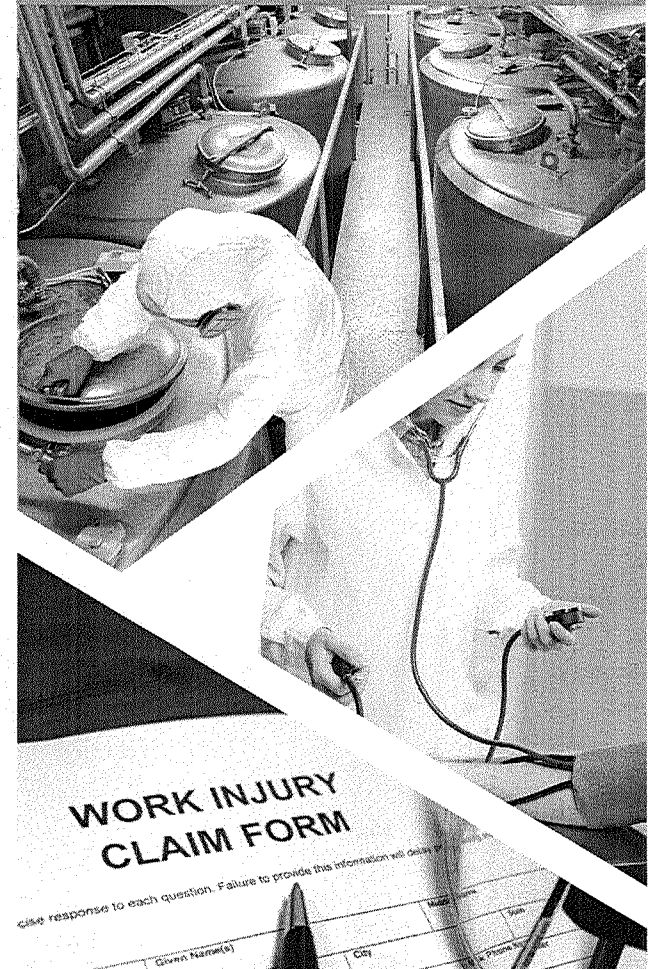
