9 STORAGE TANKS AND SECONDARY CONTAINMENT; AND FOR

## Subtitle

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13 TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING UNDERGROUND  
14 STORAGE TANKS AND SECONDARY CONTAINMENT.  
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18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 8-7-816(a)(1), concerning secondary  
21 containment for underground storage tanks, is amended to read as follows:

22 (a)(1) Each new underground storage tank or piping connected to any  
23 new underground storage tank ~~installed after July 1, 2007,~~ shall be  
24 secondarily contained and monitored for leaks ~~if the new underground storage~~  
25 ~~tank or piping is within one thousand feet (1,000') of any existing community~~  
26 ~~water system or any existing potable drinking water well.~~  
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28 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 8-7-816(b)(1), concerning secondary  
29 containment for underground storage tanks, is amended to read as follows:

30 (b)(1) Any existing underground storage tank or existing piping  
31 connected to ~~such an~~ an existing underground storage tank that is replaced ~~after~~  
32 ~~July 1, 2007,~~ shall be secondarily contained and monitored for leaks ~~if the~~  
33 ~~replaced underground storage tank or piping is within one thousand feet~~  
34 ~~(1,000') of any existing community water system or any existing potable~~  
35 ~~drinking water well.~~  
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1 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 8-7-816(b)(3), concerning secondary  
2 containment for underground storage tanks, is repealed.

3 ~~(3) With respect to piping, "replace" means to remove and put~~  
4 ~~back in more than five feet (5') of piping associated with a single~~  
5 ~~underground storage tank.~~

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7 SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 8-7-816(c)(1), concerning secondary  
8 containment for underground storage tanks, is amended to read as follows:

9 (c)(1) Each installation of a new motor fuel dispenser system or  
10 replacement of an existing motor fuel dispenser system ~~after July 1, 2007,~~  
11 shall include under-dispenser spill containment ~~if the new or replaced~~  
12 ~~dispenser is within one thousand feet (1,000') of any existing community~~  
13 ~~water system or any existing potable drinking water well.~~

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
