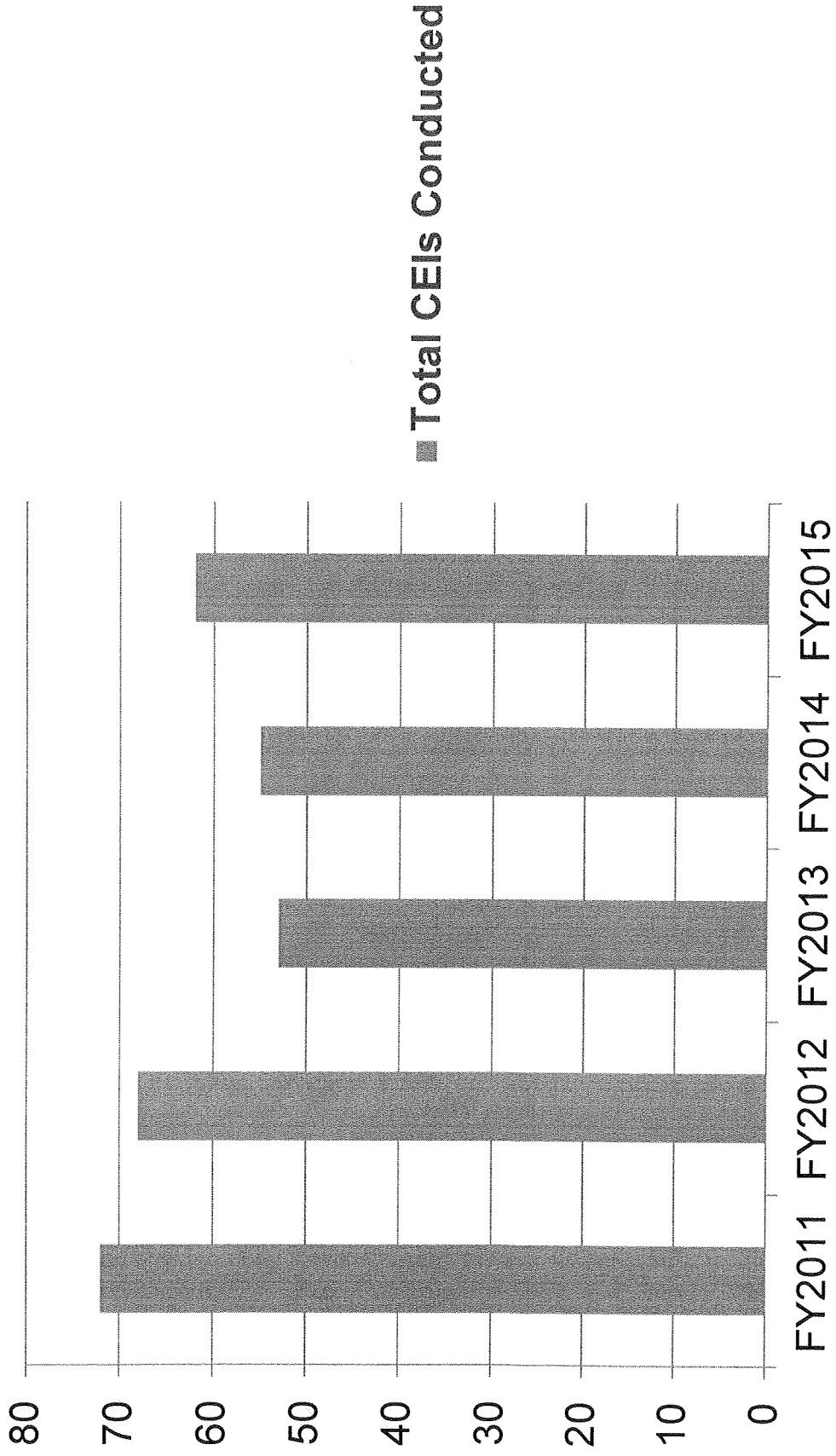

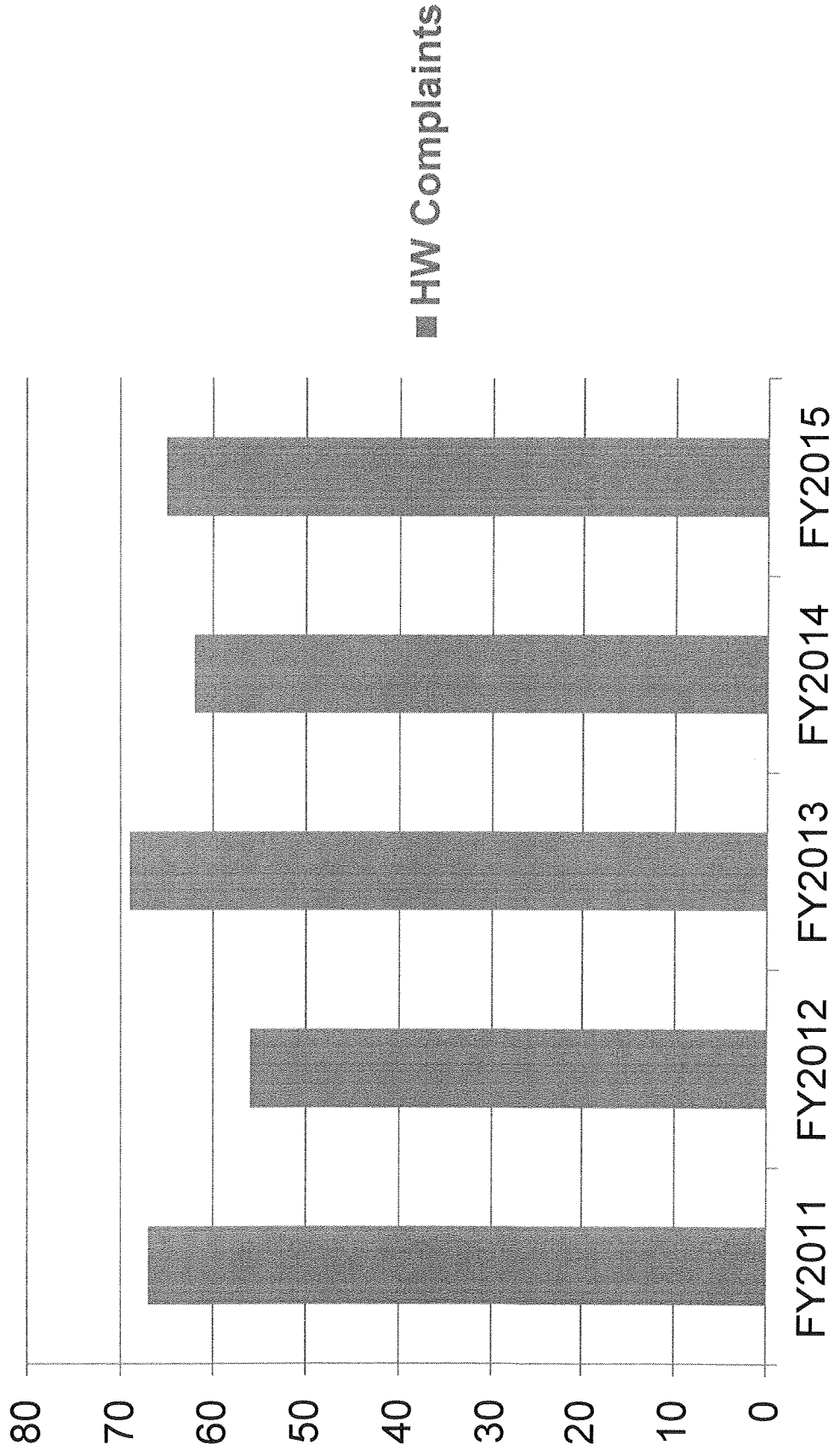

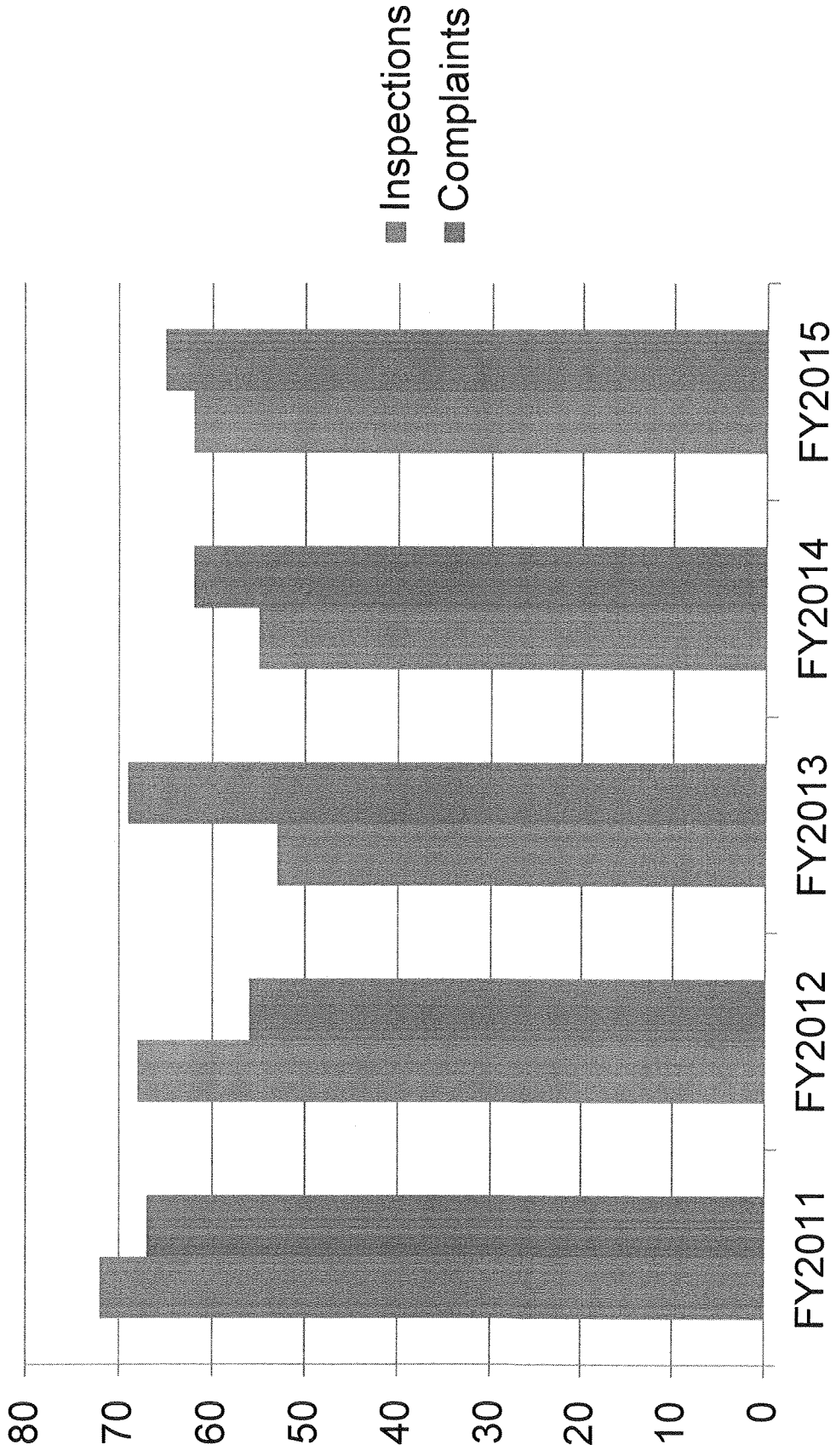
Inspections Conducted



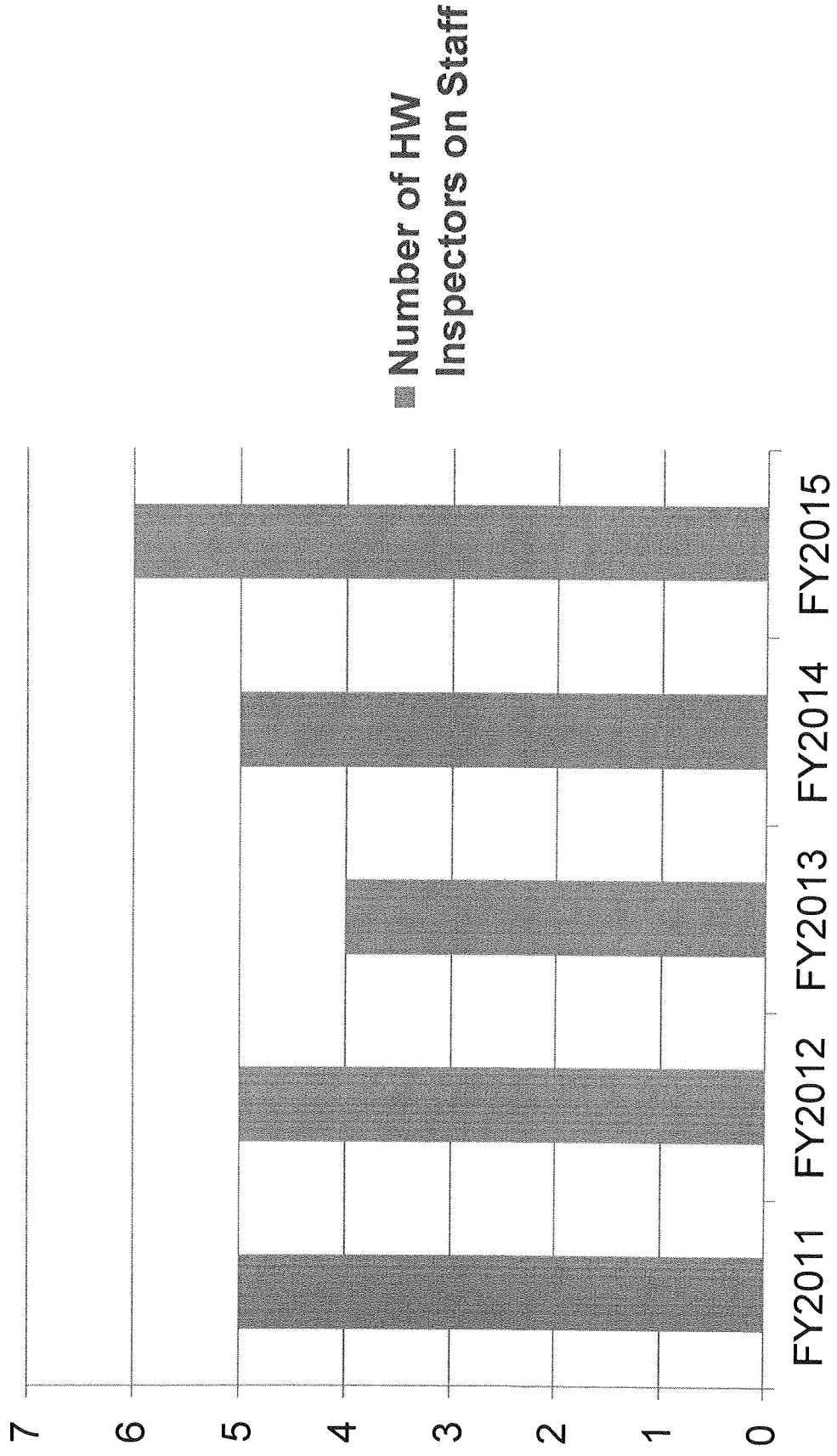
Complaints Investigated



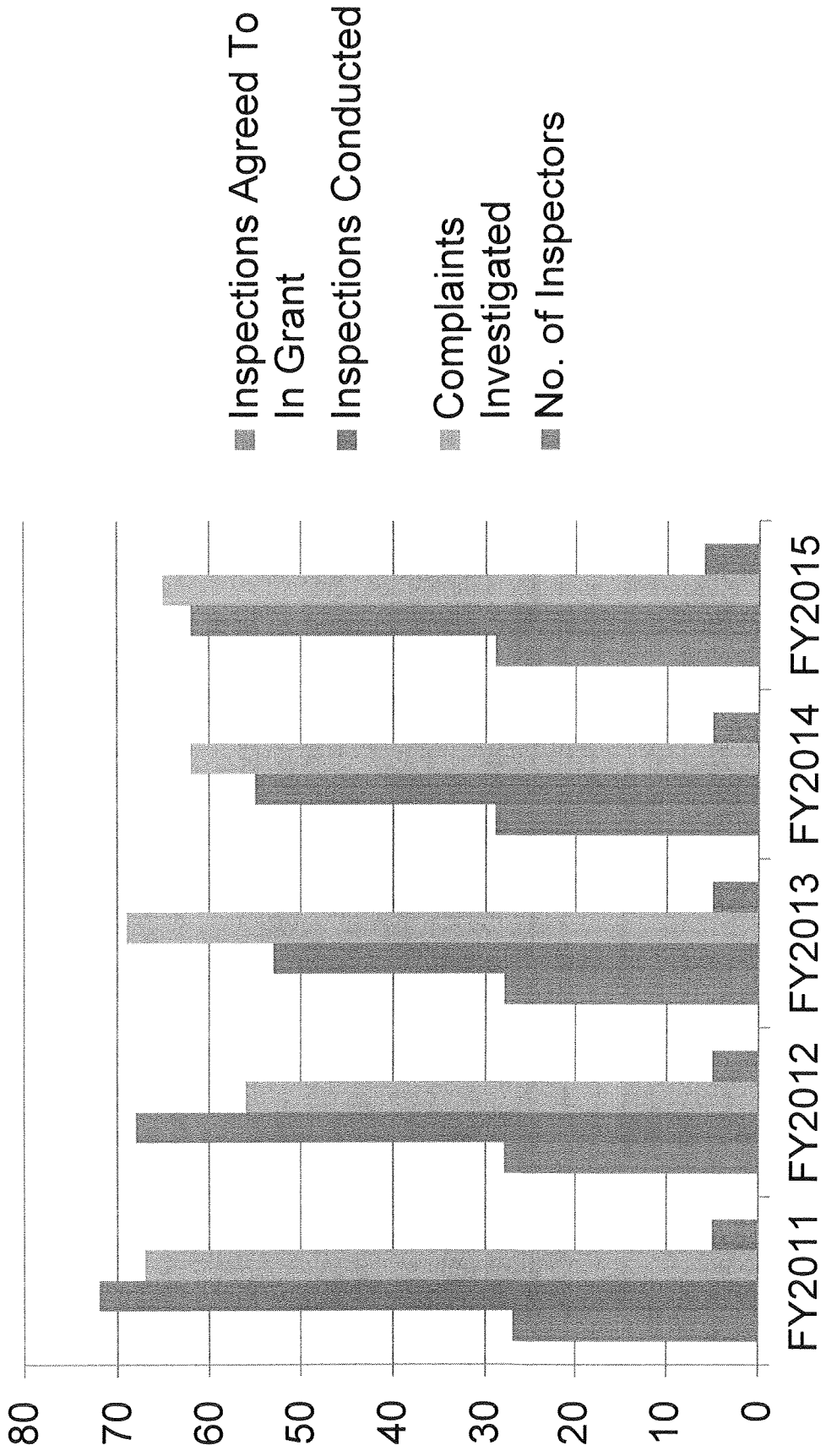
Inspections/Complaint



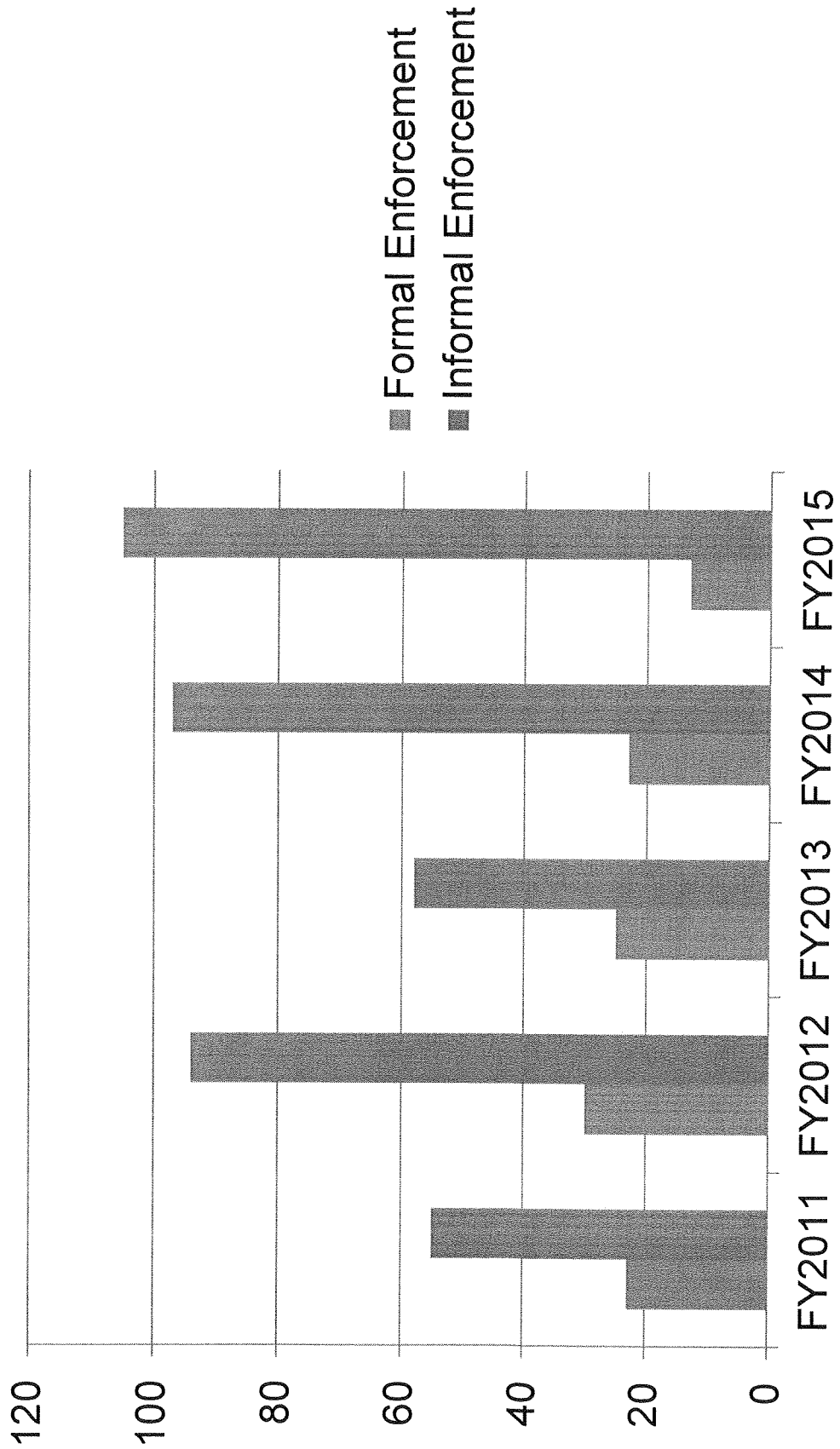

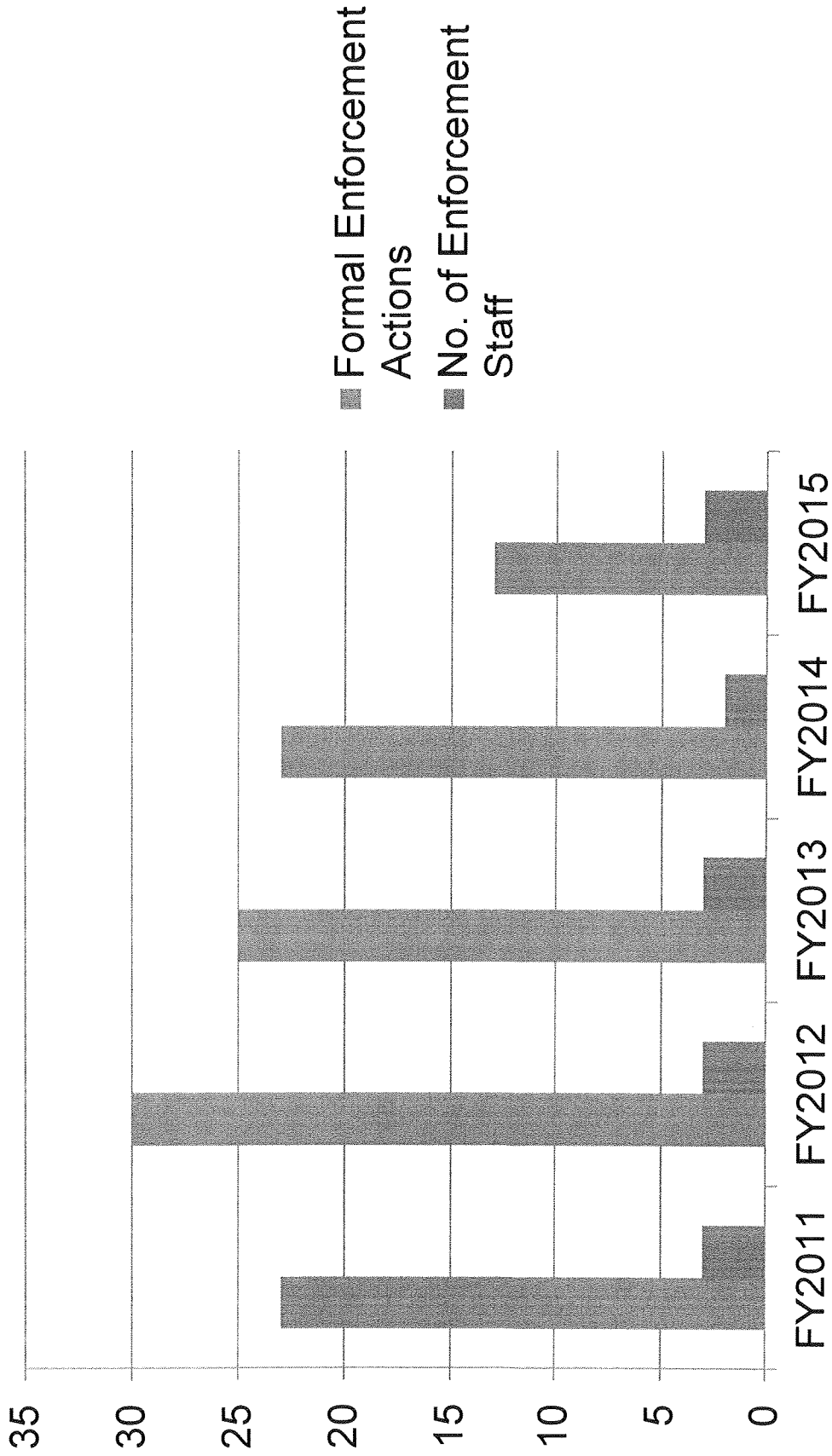
Inspection Comparison

Types of Violations Found

Informal Enforcement


- Container Management
 - Open, Lack of Labels/Dates
- Tanks
 - Cracks in Secondary Containment
 - Inspections
- Training
 - Inadequate Record Keeping
 - Lack of Job Descriptions/Job Titles
- Arrangements with Local Authorities
 - No Attempt to Make Arrangements with Police, Fire, Hospital
 - No Description of the Arrangements in the Contingency Plan




Types of Violations Found

Formal Enforcement

- Operating a Treatment Unit w/o a Permit
- Accumulating HW for >90 days
- No Tank Inspections
- No Container Inspections
- Changing Permitted Units w/o Permit Modification
