

What is NetDMR?

- Web-based tool
- Allows NPDES permittees to electronically sign and submit DMRs and attachments to EPA and ADEQ.


Why NetDMR?



- EPA Electronic Reporting Rule finalized December 2015
- All NPDES permittees are required to submit DMRs through NetDMR

by December 21, 2016







Benefits of NetDMR


- Eliminates paper DMRs
- Improves data quality & availability
- Encourages proper reporting
- Provides email confirmation of DMR submission





More Benefits

- Streamlined reporting method for facilities
- Ability to document reasons for missing data
- Attach supplemental documentation i.e. (non-compliance reports)
- Sign your DMRs from anywhere (vacation)












ADEQ Training



Who Needs an Account?

- The Signatory, whoever signs the DMRS, must be the first to request access in NetDMR.
 - Signatories must be the Cognizant or Responsible Officials for a facility.
- All Signatory roles must be approved by ADEQ.
- The original, signed Subscriber Agreement must be mailed to the ADEQ for NetDMR access.
- The facility users will request access as a Permittee.



Who Needs an Account?, Cont'd.

- The facility may have multiple roles for one permit.
 - Signatory Data Entry, Edit, Signs and Submits DMRs, and approves other roles
 - Edit Data Entry and Edit only
 - View Looks at DMRs only
- Each user must create a separate account.



Who Needs an Account?, Cont'd.

- Labs, Consultants, and Contractors will request access as a Data Provider after the Signatory's account is approved by ADEQ.
 - Cannot sign and submit DMRS. Data Entry and Edit roles only.
- The Signatory will approve these accounts.
