The creation of the DEQ COVID-19 webpage and the DEQ Provisional COVID-19 Enforcement Guidance follows the release of E&E Enforcement Guidance on March 30, 2020. The E&E guidance established a procedure for submitting COVID-19 related enforcement discretion requests to E&E via a dedicated e-mail address. According to E&E, staff will "work diligently to expeditiously review and respond to incoming requests from regulated entities."

The E&E guidance follows the issuance of a March 26 United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Memorandum addressing "COVID-19 Implications for EPA's Enforcement Assurance Program".
