The AWRC is a water resource institution. It was established, along with similar institutions at land-grant universities, through the 1964 passage of the federal Water Resources Act. The organization states that in cooperation with the U.S. Geological Survey and the National Institute of Water Resources it has "helped local, state and federal agencies learn to manage Arkansas' water resources for more than 30 years."
