## State Drinking Water Distribution System Survey: Association of State Drinking Water Administrators White Paper

09/29/2020

The Association of State Drinking Water Administrators ("ASDWA") released a September 2020 White Paper titled:

State Drinking Water Distribution System Survey ("White Paper")

The White Paper summarizes findings from a survey that the ASDWA undertook of its members on distribution system issues.

The Survey was undertaken by ASDWA's Regulatory Committee. It was undertaken to determine:

- What distribution system issues are most commonly faced by state water programs
- Collect management practices and policies to share among the states
- Collect additional information useful to inform future regulations

Forty-one states and territories completed the Survey.

Results of the Survey include:

- More than 50 percent of the respondents believe there are gaps in the current regulations for distribution systems
- Coordination of responsibility for delivered water quality between wholesale and purchased water systems
- Absence of consecutive system regulations for monitoring and maintenance
- Need for clarity or expansion in the definition of a public water system to include large distribution systems that are not currently regulated
- Disinfectant residual issues
- Storage tank issues
- Increased sharing of state successes through webinars and conferences
