 - 1. Address Waters of the United States Definition
 - 2. Address § 401 Water Quality Certifications
- 3. Prioritize Environmental Justice.
- 4. Restore the National Environmental Policy Act
- 5. Protect Public Lands and Waters from Fossil Fuel Extraction
