Electric Vehicle Charging Stations/Funding Programs: Arkansas Department of Energy & Environment Distributes Webinar Slides/Guidance Documents

The Arkansas Department of Energy & Environment ("ADEE") Energy Office is distributing a slide deck and guidance documents associated with its electric vehicle charging stations funding programs.

ADEE had previously issued a January 24th news release referencing two electric vehicle charging stations funding programs that include:

- Level 2 Electric Vehicle Supply Equipment Program (providing rebates for the installation of Level 2 electric vehicle charging stations/described as being capable of fully charging electric vehicles in eight hours or less using a 240 volt output)
- 150-Kilowatt DC Fast Charge Stations (charging stations described as being capable of charging electric vehicles in as little as 30 minutes)
