Air Enforcement: Missouri Department of Natural Resources and Perryville Auto Parts Manufacturer Enter into Administrative Order on Consent

The Missouri Department of Natural Resources (“MDNR”) and TG Missouri Corporation (“TG”) entered into a January 8th Administrative Order on Consent (“AOC”) addressing an alleged violation of an Air Permit. See No. ACPC-2026-001.

The AOC provides that TG owns and operates a manufacturing facility for plastic and metal automobile parts and accessories in Perryville, Missouri.

The facility is stated to operate pursuant to a Part 70 Operating Permit (“Permit”). The Permit requires TG to file complete application for renewal of the operating permit at least six months and no more than eighteen months before the date of permit expiration.

MDNR is stated to have issued Referral Notice of Violation on August 25, 2025, to TG to document the violations of 10 CSR 10-6.065(5)(B)1.A.(III) “Operating Permits” and the violation of 10 CSR 10-6.065(1)(C)1. “Operating Permits.”

The AOC alleges that TG:

- Failed to submit a complete operating permit renewal application at least 6 months prior to the expiration.
- Operated without a valid operating permit.

The AOC assesses a civil penalty of \$3,750.00.
