

Arkansas Advisory Committee on Petroleum Storage Tanks: March Meeting Moved to April 1st

As noted in a previous blog post, Arkansas operates a petroleum storage tank trust fund that provides reimbursement for eligible storage tanks that suffer corrective action requirements and third-party damage claims due to a release of petroleum.

The Advisory Committee on Petroleum Storage Tanks meets monthly at the Arkansas Department of Energy and Environment – Division of Environmental Quality to review reimbursement claims.

The Advisory Committee sent out a March 17th notice stating:

Please be aware that the Petroleum Storage Tank Trust Fund Advisory Committee will not meet on March 25, 2026, as regularly scheduled. The meeting has been pushed to the next Wednesday (April 1, 2026) at 9:00 am.
