Recycling Materials Association (Formally Known as the Institute of Scrap Recycling Industries): Gulf Coast Chapter Awards Scholarships to Two Arkansas College Students

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The Recycling Materials Association announced that the Gulf Coast Chapter of the Organization awarded \$48,000 in scholarships to twenty-four college students.

Two Arkansas college students were among the awardees.

\$2,000 scholarships were awarded to:

- Alyssa Winner; Harding University

Both Arkansas students were sponsored by Metal Recycling Corp whose headquarters are based in Little Rock, Arkansas.

The awards apply toward tuition at any accredited educational institution designed to meet the requirements for an academic, professional, or occupational degree for the 2026-2027 academic year.
