Arkansas Natural Resources Commission: Proposed Revisions to Rules Governing Conservation Districts

The Arkansas Natural Resources Commission ("ANRC") is proposing to revise its rules governing Conservation District operations ("Draft Rules").

The rules governing conservation districts are referenced as Title 2 of ANRC's rules.

The Title 2 rules provide general operating requirements for districts created under the Arkansas Conservation District Law. See Ark. Code Ann. § 14-125-101, et seq.

Arkansas' conservation districts are governed by a board of five volunteers serving in an elected or appointed positions. The ANRC assists the districts with implementation of conservation programs along with funding of the districts.

The Draft Rules:

- Create a Conservation District Directors Emeritus Program
- Clarify election responsibilities of district directors during district elections
- Increase voter participation by allowing early voting in district elections
- Streamline district operating procedures and reflect current funding procedures

ANRC will hold a public hearing on the Draft Rules on February 18th at the agency's headquarters at 101 East Capitol, Suite 350 in Little Rock, Arkansas. The hearing will begin at 2:00 p.m.
