The Lecture will be held on November 2nd at the University of Arkansas in Fayetteville, Arkansas. The Lecture is state to be part of the Biological and Agricultural Engineering department seminar series.

Dr. Lowrance is described as:

. . . the senior adviser for nutrient management and HABs (harmful algal blooms) at the National Risk Management Research Lab with the Environmental Protection Agency. Lowrance and his colleagues conduct research focused on remediating degraded sites and restoring ecosystem services. They also provide technical assistance to landowners who want to help protect water quality.
