AGREED ORDER

COME NOW the Mississippi Commission on Environmental Quality (Commission), acting through the staff and Executive Director of the Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ), Complainant, and DR Horton, Inc., Respondent, in the above captioned cause and agree as follows:

1.

By letter dated August 19, 2021, Respondent was contacted by Complainant and notified of the following violations that were discovered during a Compliance Evaluation Inspection at its Meginley Subdivision construction site located on Lamey Bridge Road in D'Iberville, Mississippi in Harrison County:

- A. ACT6, Condition S-1 (1): Failure to implement the SWPPP.
- B. ACT6, Condition S-3 (11): Failure to maintain erosion controls.
- C. ACT7, Condition L-1 (2): Failure to meet non-numeric limitation requirements.

2.

By letter dated June 6, 2022, Respondent asserted the violations have been corrected.

In lieu of a formal enforcement hearing concerning the violations listed above, Complainant and Respondent agree to settle this matter as follows:

A. Respondent agrees to pay and Complainant agrees to accept a civil penalty in the amount of \$18,750.00. Respondent shall pay this penalty to MDEQ within forty-five (45) days after this Agreed Order has been executed by the MDEQ Executive Director or his designee. The settlement payment shall be submitted to:

Nothing in this Agreed Order shall limit the rights of MDEQ or the Commission in the event Respondent fails to comply with this Agreed Order. The Agreed Order shall be strictly construed to apply to those matters expressly resolved herein.

Nothing contained in this Agreed Order shall limit the rights of MDEQ or the Commission to take enforcement or other actions against Respondent for violations not addressed herein and for future violations of environmental laws, rules, and regulations.

Respondent understands and acknowledges that it is entitled to an evidentiary hearing before the Commission pursuant to Miss. Code Ann. § 49-17-31, and that it has made an informed waiver of that right.
