Submission Topics

We welcome papers addressing a wide range of legal perspectives. Specific areas of interest include, but are not limited to climate change, environmental justice, energy and infrastructure, artificial intelligence, privacy and data governance, cybersecurity, intellectual property, AI data centers, sustainability, and emerging regulatory challenges. Interdisciplinary and comparative perspectives are encouraged.

Formatting & Submission Guidelines

To be considered, submissions must adhere to the following requirements:

- Length: Submissions should not exceed 50 double-spaced pages, including footnotes, unless prior approval is obtained from the Editorial Board.
- Format: Microsoft Word (.doc or .docx).
- Citation Style: Footnotes must conform to *The Bluebook: A Uniform System of Citation* (current edition).
