NOTICE

ALL RETAIL FUEL STATIONS WITH MECHANICAL DISPENSERS AUTHORIZED TO SELL IN HALF-GALLON INCREMENTS

The Arkansas Department of Agriculture - Bureau of Standards (Department) has been notified that gasoline prices are, or will soon be, higher than can be displayed by mechanical dispensers. These mechanical dispensers require conversion kits to display higher fuel prices and obtaining these kits may take several weeks due to supply chain issues.

Therefore, the Department authorizes retail fuel outlets to display and sell fuel in half-gallon increments from **mechanical pumps only**. The allowance will begin on March 11, 2022 and expire on July 1, 2022.

All retail locations that sell fuel in half-gallon increments shall display signage on the pump giving notice of the half-gallon pricing. The signage must use capitalized letters a minimum of three inches in height and state the following:

"ALL FUEL PRICES ARE IN CENTS PER HALF (1/2) GALLON. SEE INSIDE ATTENDANT FOR FULL PRICE."
