## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW REGARDING THE DUTIES OF THE  
10 COMPLIANCE ADVISORY PANEL AND THE ARKANSAS DEPARTMENT  
11 OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY RELATED TO THE COLLECTION  
12 AND RECYCLING OR DISPOSAL OF EXTRA-LARGE TIRES; TO  
13 TRANSFER MONEYS INTO THE USED TIRE RECYCLING FUND;  
14 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

17 TO AMEND THE LAW REGARDING THE DUTIES OF  
18 THE COMPLIANCE ADVISORY PANEL AND THE  
19 ARKANSAS DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL  
20 QUALITY RELATED TO EXTRA-LARGE TIRES; AND  
21 TO TRANSFER MONEYS INTO THE USED TIRE  
22 RECYCLING FUND.

26 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
27

28 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 8-4-314(j)(5), concerning the duties of the  
29 Compliance Advisory Panel, is amended to read as follows:

30 (5) Advise and assist state and local officials in all areas of  
31 recyclables marketing, including without limitation the implementation,  
32 administration, and funding of the collection and recycling or collection and  
33 disposal of extra-large tires as defined in § 8-9-402.

35 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 8-9-202, concerning powers and duties of the  
36 Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality regarding recycling, is amended



1 to add an additional subdivision to read as follows:

2 (4) Implement, administer, and fund the collection and recycling  
3 or collection and disposal of extra-large tires as defined in § 8-9-402 with  
4 the advice and assistance of the Compliance Advisory Panel.

SECTION 3. TEMPORARY LANGUAGE. DO NOT CODIFY. FUNDING TRANSFER.

Immediately upon the effective date of this act, the Chief Fiscal  
Officer of the State shall transfer on his or her books and those of the  
Treasurer of State and the Auditor of the State the sum of three hundred  
thousand dollars (\$300,000) from the Marketing Recyclables Program Fund to  
the Used Tire Recycling Fund to be used exclusively for the purposes of  
implementing, administering, and funding the collection and recycling or  
collection and disposal of extra-large tires as defined in § 8-9-402.
