30	SECTION 1. Ark	cansas Code Title 8, Chapter 4, Subcha	apter 2, is amended
31	to add an additional	section to read as follows:	
32	8-4-234. Short	-term activity authorization.	
33	<u>(a)(l) The Dir</u>	ector of the Arkansas Department of I	Environmental
34	Quality may authorize	short-term activities that have pote	ential to affect
35	compliance with Arkan	nsas water quality standards if:	
36	<u>(A)</u>	The short-term activity is essentia	al to the protection

1	or promotion of the public interest; and		
2	(B) No permanent or long-term impairment of beneficial		
3	uses is likely to result from the short-term activity.		
4	(2) Short-term activities eligible for authorization include		
5	without limitation:		
6	(A) Wastewater treatment facility maintenance;		
7	(B) Fish eradication projects;		
8	(C) Mosquito abatement projects;		
9	(D) Algae and weed control projects;		
10	(E) Dredge and fill projects;		
11	(F) Construction activities; or		
12	(G) Activities that result in overall enhancement or		
13	maintenance of beneficial uses.		
14	(b)(l) The Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality may collect a		
15	processing fee for a short-term activity authorization.		
16	(2) The short-term activity authorization fee shall not exceed		
17	two hundred dollars (\$200) for each stream crossing, in-stream activity, or		
18	other eligible activity under subdivision (a)(2) of this section at each site		
19	identified in the application.		
20	(3) The Arkansas Pollution Control and Ecology Commission may		
21	establish a fee schedule for short-term activity authorization fees imposed		
22	on a state agency, board, or commission or municipality, city, or county for		
23	an short-term activity not covered under subsection (c) of this section to		
24	include without limitation:		
25	(A) Routine maintenance; or		
26	(B) Road construction.		
27	(4)(A) The department shall enter into an agreement with a state		
28	agency, board, or commission or municipality, city, or county that creates an		
29	alternative payment structure in lieu of fees authorized under subdivision		
30	(b)(2) of this section.		
31	(B) An agreement entered into under subdivision (b)(4)(A)		
32	of this section shall include:		
33	(i) A provision regarding waiver of fees under this		
34	section; and		
35	(ii) A process under which the department provides		
36	notice to the state agency, board, or commission or municipality, city, or		

1	county of planned actions under this section that affect the state agency,		
2	board, or commission or municipality, city, or county.		
3	(5) The department shall waive twenty-five percent (25%) of a		
4	fee assessed under this section to a state agency, board, or commission or		
5	municipality, city, or county in a fiscal year.		
6	(c)(1) At the request of a state agency, board, or commission or		
7	municipality, city, or county, the director shall waive the short-term		
8	activity authorization fee under subsection (b) of this section to facilitate		
9	emergency activity limited to the following:		
10	(A) Storm debris removal necessary to prevent damage to a		
11	bridge, road, or other structure;		
12	(B) Emergency bridge maintenance or repair; or		
13	(C) Emergency road maintenance or repair.		
14	(2) A state agency, board, or commission or municipality, city,		
15	or county that submits a request for a waiver of the short-term activity		
16	authorization fee under subdivision (c)(l) of this section shall provide the		
17	department:		
18	(A) Notice by phone or email before commencing any in-		
19	stream activity;		
20	(B) A written request for waiver of the short-term		
21	activity authorization fee that includes:		
22	(1) A request that the short-term activity fee be		
23	waived; and		
24	(11) A statement that describes the emergency		
25	conditions that require the short-term activity; and		
26	(C) Written notice of completion, including detailed		
27	information concerning all in-stream activity.		
28	(d) The director shall determine the necessary conditions for the		
29	authorization under this section.		
30	(e) This section does not supersede existing state or federal		
31	permitting processes or requirements.		
32	(f) The commission may promulgate regulations for the administration		
33	of this section.
