#### AGREED ORDER

COME NOW the Mississippi Commission on Environmental Quality (Commission), acting through the staff and Executive Director of the Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ), Complainant, and Calgon Carbon Corporation, Respondent, in the above captioned cause and agree as follows:

1.

By letter dated January 6, 2025, Respondent was contacted by Complainant and notified of the following violations of Permit to Construct Air Emissions Equipment No. 1000-00015 at its facility located in Hancock County:

- Condition 3.14: Respondent failed to demonstrate compliance with Nitrogen Oxides Α. (NOx) limitation of 4.19 pounds per hour (lb/hr) (3-hour average) during a stack test of Emission Point AA-034 on August 14, 2024. Respondent emitted 5.10 lb/hr of NOx during the stack test. Subsequently, Respondent demonstrated compliance with the NOx limitation during a retest on December 18, 2024.
- В. Condition 3.18: Respondent failed to demonstrate compliance with Nitrogen Oxides (NOx) limitation of 4.19 pounds per hour (lb/hr) (3-hour average) during a stack test of Emission Point AA-035 on August 13, 2024. Respondent emitted 4.40 lb/hr of NOx during the stack test. Subsequently, Respondent demonstrated compliance with

In lieu of a formal enforcement hearing concerning the violations listed above, Complainant and Respondent agree to settle this matter as follows:

A. Respondent agrees to pay and Complainant agrees to accept a civil penalty in the amount of \$56,000.00. Respondent shall pay this penalty to MDEQ within forty-five (45) days after this Agreed Order has been executed by the MDEQ Executive Director or his designee. The settlement payment shall be submitted to:

Nothing in this Agreed Order shall limit the rights of MDEQ or the Commission in the event Respondent fails to comply with this Agreed Order. The Agreed Order shall be strictly construed to apply to those matters expressly resolved herein.

Nothing contained in this Agreed Order shall limit the rights of MDEQ or the Commission to take enforcement or other actions against Respondent for violations not addressed herein and for future violations of environmental laws, rules, and regulations.

5.

Respondent understands and acknowledges that it is entitled to an evidentiary hearing before the Commission pursuant to Miss. Code Ann. § 49-17-31, and that it has made an informed waiver of that right.
