AGREED ORDER

COME NOW the Mississippi Commission on Environmental Quality (Commission), acting through the staff and Executive Director of the Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ), Complainant, and Rite-Hite Products Corporation, Respondent, in the above captioned cause and agree as follows:

1.

By letter dated May 29, 2026, Respondent was contacted by Complainant and notified of the following violation of Title V Operating Permit No. 0680-00109 (the Permit) at its facility located at 601 Expressway Drive, Horn Lake, Mississippi in Desoto County:

- A. Respondent failed to submit a timely renewal application to the Mississippi Environmental Quality Permit Board (the Permit Board) in violation of Condition 1.17 of the Permit which states, "Expiration of this permit terminates the permittee's right to operate unless a timely and complete renewal application has been submitted. A timely application is one which is submitted at least six (6) months prior to expiration of the Title V permit. If the permittee submits a timely and complete application, the failure to have a Title V permit is not a violation of regulations until the Permit Board takes final action on the permit application. This protection shall cease to apply if, subsequent to the completeness determination, the permittee fails to

submit by the deadline specified in writing by the MDEQ any additional information identified as being needed to process the application.” The Permit expired on November 30, 2025; therefore, the renewal application was due on May 31, 2025.

On or about June 6, 2025, Respondent submitted a permit renewal application to the Permit Board.

2.

In lieu of a formal enforcement hearing concerning the violation listed above, Complainant and Respondent agree to settle this matter as follows:

- A. Respondent shall comply with all terms and conditions of Title V Operating Permit No. 0680-00109, which was issued on December 14, 2020, until the Permit Board acts on the renewal application received on June 6, 2025.

3.

Nothing in this Agreed Order shall limit the rights of MDEQ or the Commission in the event Respondent fails to comply with this Agreed Order. The Agreed Order shall be strictly construed to apply to those matters expressly resolved herein.

4.

Nothing contained in this Agreed Order shall limit the rights of MDEQ or the Commission to take enforcement or other actions against Respondent for violations not addressed herein and for future violations of environmental laws, rules, and regulations.

5.

Respondent understands and acknowledges that it is entitled to an evidentiary hearing before the Commission pursuant to Miss. Code Ann. § 49-17-31, and that it has made an informed waiver of that right.

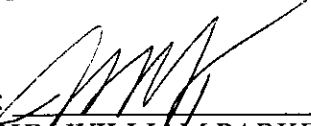

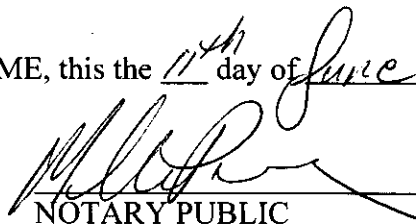
