1 Overview

A Background

The 2018 Farm Bill was extended by the American Relief Act, 2025 (Pub. L 118-158) which extends CRP authority until September 30, 2025.

Notice CRP-1036 restricted processing new offers and approving new CRP contracts for all signup types after September 30, 2024, because of expiring authority.

This notice is applicable to all continuous offers **including** CREP.

B Purpose

This notice provides authorities and guidance for County Offices to begin processing offers to be batched and accepted under all continuous signup initiatives, including CREP. This notice also provides:

- policy for:
 - continuous CRP signup 63
 - batching all continuous CRP offers
 - offer processing
- required practice information for conservation plans
- Memorandum of Agreement Between NRCS, FSA, and CCC (MOA) extension
- FY 2025 continuous CRP deadlines
- Exhibit 1, Updated CRP-1, CRP-2C, and CRP-2C30.

2 Policy for Continuous CRP Signup 63 Beginning May 12, 2025

A New Signup Number and Dates

For program administration purposes, the continuous CRP signup number will change from signup 61 to signup 63.

Beginning May 12, 2025, owners or operators may submit non-CREP and CREP continuous signup 63 offers for:

- new land
- combination of new land and land scheduled to expire from CRP on September 30, 2025
- land scheduled to expire from CRP on September 30, 2025.

Offers accepted after July 31 may be held for approval **pending** acreage availability and further batching and acceptance. However, there is no guarantee that further batching will occur. Currently there is no authority to accept continuous CRP signup offers after September 30, 2025.

B Processing Unapproved Continuous CRP Signup 61 Offers

SU 61 producers with unapproved continuous CRP signup 61 offers will be notified of their unacceptable offer using the CRP-26.

Owners and operators interested in reoffering unapproved continuous CRP signup 61 acreage will submit a new offer under continuous CRP signup 63. County Offices will process the new offer through the Tool for Environmental Resource Results Assessment (TERRA) and the Conservation Online System (COLS) and obtain new signatures on the CRP-2C and CRP-1.

C Contract Start Dates

The effective start date for all non-CREP continuous and CREP continuous signup 63 contracts will be no earlier than October 1, 2025. Producers may defer the effective start date up to 6 months for new land (land not currently enrolled in CRP). See 2-CRP, subparagraph 213 B.

D Maximum Payment Rate

County Offices will follow 2-CRP, paragraph 101 to explain the maximum payment rate to producers before submitting an offer. The maximum payment rate is the maximum per-acre rental rate CCC is willing to pay for the eligible acreage offered. Offers submitted above the calculated maximum payment rate will not be accepted. The following are the maximum per -acre payment rate limitations:

- \$300 per-acre for non-CREP continuous CRP
- \$380 per-acre for CLEAR30.

Policy for Continuous Signup 63 Beginning May 12, 2025 (Continued)

E Climate-Smart Incentives

The 3, 5, and 10 percent Climate-Smart Practice incentives are **not authorized** for continuous signup practices for signup 63.

F Water Quality Incentive

A 20 percent per acre annual rental rate water quality incentive will be added to the weighted average SRR for clean lakes, estuaries, and rivers (CLEAR initiative) practices offered under continuous signup 63, including CLEAR30.

G CLEAR30 Rental Rate Adjustment

A 23.2 percent per-acre annual rental rate adjustment is authorized for all continuous signup 63 CLEAR30 offers.

H Conservation Practice Change

A new CRP Suitability and Feasibility Worksheet is required when the expiring conservation practice is changed.

I Updated CRP-1, CRP-2C, and CRP-2C30 Forms and Fact Sheets

Public Burden Statements were updated to reference the **American Relief Act, 2025 (Pub. L. 118-158)** and revise the non-discrimination statement (NDS). CRP-1, CRP-2C, and CRP-2C30 are:

- computer-generated forms
- provided for display purposes only (Exhibit 1).

J Software and New Functionality to Print Automated Participant Notification Letters

COLS will be updated to process continuous CRP signup 63 offers. Changing from signup 61 to signup 63 applies to continuous CRP signup, including CREP.

TERRA and COLS will be used for all continuous CRP signup 63 offers, including CREP.

CRP-23, CRP-24, and CRP-26 can now be printed from COLS from the Print Forms Screen. The <u>COLS Producer Notification Letters</u> video training can be found in the <u>Farm Program Training</u> library.

3 Batching of All Continuous CRP Offers Including CREP

A Batching Offers for Signup 63

The 2018 Farm Bill requires that no more than 27 million acres can be enrolled in CRP. Current enrollment in CRP is approximately 25.9 million acres. Contracts totaling approximately 957,393 acres are scheduled to expire on September 30, 2025.

B Batching Period(s) for Signup 63

To ensure the acreage enrolled does not exceed the statutory limitation, beginning on May 12, 2025, FSA will accept and batch all continuous CRP offers, including CREP, as follows:

- accepted on a non-competitive first-come, first-serve basis
- placed in a batch process to ensure program enrollment levels do not exceed the statutory acreage cap
- approved by COC following notification from the National Office of acceptable offers announced through a future policy notice.

Note: County Offices will not submit offers to NRCS for conservation planning until notified of an acceptable status by the National Office.

The following table displays the first batching period for continuous offers, including CREP.

Note: Additional batching periods may be announced depending on acreage availability below the statutory acreage cap.

Both CRP-1 and applicable CRP-2C or CRP-2C30 must be completed, signed by an eligible owner or operator, and received in the County Office for the offer to be considered submitted. To be considered in the batching period, the County Office will update the offer to a "Submitted" status in COLS by COB on June 6, 2025. Submitted continuous offers, including CREP, will **not** be approved until a policy notice with a list of acceptable signup 63 offers from the batching period is published.

County Offices will continue to take offers after June 6, 2025, and ensure producers understand there is no guarantee when and if the offer will be batched and accepted. A subsequent notice will be issued to address continuous offers submitted after June 6, 2025.

4 Offer Processing

A How to Process Offers

County Offices will:

- process all continuous CRP signup 63 offers according to 2-CRP and 4-CRP
- follow 2-CRP, subparagraph 171 C for the continuous signup process flow.

Note: Manual CRP-1's, CRP-2C's, and CRP-2C30's are not authorized.

5 Required Practice Information for Conservation Plans

A Job Sheets or Implementation Requirements

FSA State conservation program specialists will work with NRCS State CRP program managers to update or review implementation requirements and provide to County Offices for all continuous CRP practices. This step is critical to ensure all practice implementation components are included so FSA and the participant clearly understand how the practice will be installed, managed, and maintained.

In addition to the material outlined in the National Planning Procedures Handbook, the conservation plan must include information and implementation requirements on the following:

- vegetative or cover establishment
- herbicides, insecticide, or mechanical weed control
- required management activities
- engineering plans.

Implementation requirements will include the information needed for County Offices to develop the cost share agreement (FSA-848) with applicable practice components needed to ensure the practice is completed according to NRCS standards and specifications.

6 Memorandum of Agreement Between NRCS, FSA, and CCC (MOA)

A MOA extension with NRCS

The current MOA signed by FSA and NRCS in October 2019 which expired in September 2023 has been extended. Both parties have agreed to operate under the terms and conditions of the amended agreement until a new MOA is executed.

7 Interim Conservation Plans

A Authority for Interim Conservation Plans

Interim Conservation Plans will be authorized for use in continuous CRP signup 63. Policy and guidance regarding their completion will be included in a future policy notice.
